The Grant is a onetime support. Additional funding will not be provided.

The Swahili Performing Arts Center shall submit a brief narrative report on the activities carried out, and on the results achieved.

A financial report, verified by The Swahili Performing Arts Center financially responsible Person or in another way, for the total cost connected with the activities being supported, shall be submitted not later than three months after completion of the activities. The financial report shall compare actual expenditure with approved budget.

At the end of the activities supported, unused funds exceeding a total of NOK 1.000, - shall be deposited in the RNE's account no. 76940513487 in DnB NOR ASA by credit transfer. 
